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## **TUITION AND FEES POLICY**

**DAY CAMP PROGRAM**   **Ages:** 2½ (potty trained) through 8<sup>th</sup> grade (completed in June 2019)   **Times:** 7:00 am – 5:30 pm  
**Costs:** Registration Fee: \$50 per camper (nonrefundable)   Daily Rate: \$45 per day   Weekly Discounted Rate: \$205 per week

### **GENERAL TUITION AND FEES GUIDELINES**

- Admittance into TCA Summer Adventure Camp is on a first come first serve basis.
- The registration fee of \$50 per camper is nonrefundable.
- All fees may be paid online through the online portal including camp tuition and trips.
- There are no refunds of any paid tuition/trips. There are also no refunds or deductions made for vacation, holidays or sicknesses.
- Any camper not picked up by 5:30 pm will be assessed a late charge of \$1 per minute per child.

## **DISCIPLINE and EXPULSION POLICY**

Summer Adventure Camp is an extension of the ministry of Timothy Christian Academy and operates under the same religious values as the school. By registering your child(ren) in camp, you agree to be respectful and supportive of the values of TCA. Camp staff members are Christians who serve and behave in a godly manner. All campers are expected to be a contributing member of the Summer Adventure Camp at TCA. Likewise, campers are expected to behave in a manner that provides a safe and supportive learning environment for all participants. Campers who act outside of this manner will be asked not to return to camp. There are reasons we may need to suspend or expel a child from camp. We will first do everything possible to work with the student and his/her family in order to prevent this policy from being implemented. When appropriate, a suspension may be implemented to provide a period of time that the parent can work with their child regarding the specific behavior or to negotiate an agreement with TCA. Failure of the student to satisfy the terms of the plan will result in permanent expulsion from the camp. The following are some reasons for which we may suspend or expel a student from the camp:

### **CHILD'S ACTIONS FOR SUSPENSION/EXPULSION**

Child is at risk of causing serious injury to self, students, and/or staff, failure to adjust to the camp program after a reasonable amount of time

### **PARENTAL ACTIONS FOR STUDENT'S SUSPENSION/EXPULSION**

Parent threatens physical or intimidating actions toward the TCA staff or students, parent exhibits verbal abuse to staff in front of enrolled children, failure to pay tuition or habitual lateness in payments, failure to complete required forms, habitual tardiness when picking up your child

### **SCHEDULE OF SUSPENSION/EXPULSION**

If remedial intervention/action has proven ineffective, the parent will be notified, verbally and/or in writing regarding the specific behavior warranting the suspension or expulsion, the parent will be informed, verbally and/or in writing, regarding the length of a suspension, the parent will be informed verbally and/or in writing of the specific behavior change required in order that the child or parent may return to camp following a suspension

### **PROACTIVE ACTIONS IN ORDER TO PREVENT SUSPENSION/EXPULSION**

Staff will redirect child from negative behavior, staff will reassess camp environment, appropriateness of activities and supervision, staff will use positive methods and language while disciplining children, staff will praise appropriate behaviors, staff will consistently apply consequences for rules, child will be given verbal warnings, child will be given time to gain control, disruptive behavior will be documented and maintained in confidentiality, parent will be provided with written copies of the disruptive behaviors that could lead to suspension/expulsion
